This collaboration aims to develop self-reliant, socially responsible young people who value and respect cultural diversity. St. Martin supports vocational training colleges (VTCs) across Laikipia by strengthening their institutional capacity to produce innovative, job-ready graduates - ensuring learners gain the skills and expertise needed for successful integration into the workforce and meaningful participation in society.

Your activities / tasks

As a Comundo Technical Advisor, you will play a key role in improving the quality and relevance of TVET in Laikipia County. Your focus will be on adapting the Dual-VET model to the local context and strengthening Vocational Training Centres (VTCs) in delivering Competency-Based Education and Training (CBET) while promoting the development of transversal (soft) skills.

Working closely with St. Martin and the Laikipia County Government, you will help contextualize and implement the Dual-VET approach in selected VTCs. Your support will include establishing industry liaison and career guidance offices, as well as fostering Public-Private Partnerships to align training with labour market needs. You will also build the capacity of VTC trainers in CBET delivery and integration of soft skills such as communication, teamwork, adaptability, and critical thinking.

Your key responsibilities will include:

- Conduct comprehensive needs assessments to identify youth skills gaps, market trends and TVET challenges.
- Refine and pilot the adapted dual-VET model and in selected VTCs.
- Strengthen links between VTCs and local industries to improve training relevance & job placement.
- Develop a framework for continuous professional development of VTC staff.
- Support youth employability through career readiness and employment linkage initiatives.
- Design and deliver training to enhance instructors competencies in CBET methodologies, transversal skills and dual education, along ongoing mentorship and support.
